A Quick Guide to Course Equivalencies

HUMANITIES ELECTIVE

Literature, Art, Language, Medical Terminology, Music, Theology/Religion, Philosophy Speech Communication/ Public Speaking (if not used for Tier 2), Critical Thinking, etc.

Studio courses do not count!

SOCIAL SCIENCE ELECTIVE

Anthropology, Economics, Geography, History, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, and Management.

SCIENCE ELECTIVE

Chemistry, Biology, Advanced Physiology, Pathophysiology, Genetics, Natural Science, Physics, Astronomy

GENERAL ELECTIVE/OPEN ELECTIVE

Any non-remedial course (at least 100 level) that is part of an approved curriculum at an accredited college and that has at least an implied theoretical base (such as a practicum) may be used as a general elective.

- May not be a gym course
- May not be a skills course (typing, shorthand)
- May not repeat courses you have already taken; may not use courses used for other Tier 1/Tier 2 transfer credit

Note about Conversion from Semester to Quarter credits:

Semester Courses run 15 weeks and therefore transfer into Drexel's 10 week quarter system at a value of **1.5 X # of Semester credits** (3 x 1.5 = 4.5 quarter credits). Credits are applied to the equivalent Drexel course credit and exceeding credits are applied where possible toward electives.

The CNHP Transcript Evaluator and Advisors will apply the conversion at the time of acceptance and determine the total amount of transfer credits.

Tier Three: Upper Division Nursing Courses

These Upper-Division Nursing Courses must be taken through Drexel University. These courses are online. The required clinical course, NURS 375, is a theory/clinical course. Meaning that the class work is completed online and clinical hours are completed at a location convenient to each student—more information is available.
